We want to transform the inside of our school to provide calm, soft, warm spaces. Young children learn in a holistic way so a key role for us is to help establish connections between ideas and concrete experiences that matter to them from their immediate family/community.

In our plan to improve communication and language development we need to offer children environments in ways that help them feel secure, give them a sense of belonging and feel comfortable.

The approach is to create softness in the environment, the use of colour and light, and also to focus on the impact of noise. In order to do this resources are essential.

Here are some examples of the items that we would like donated:
