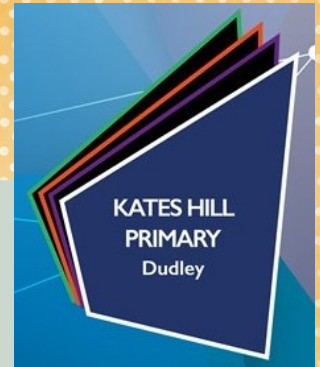

School starts 8.45am every day please make sure your child is in the playground before the bell rings. School ends at 3.15pm please collect your children on time.



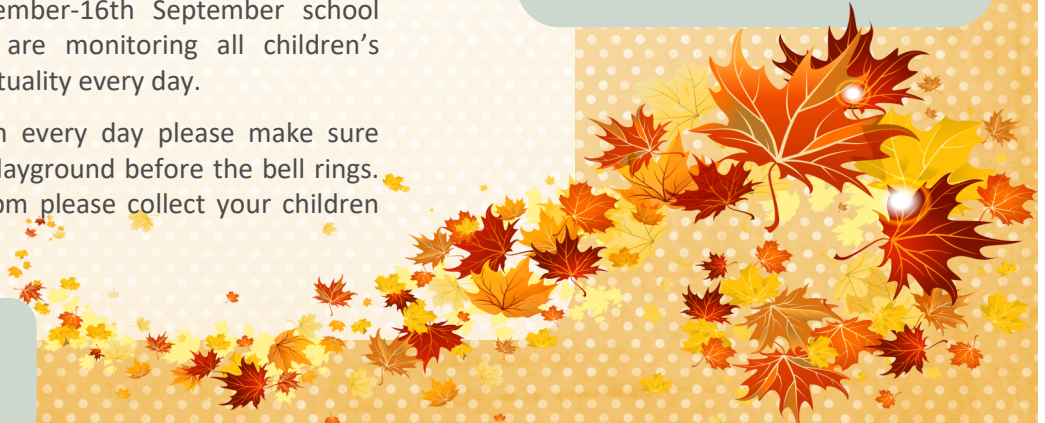

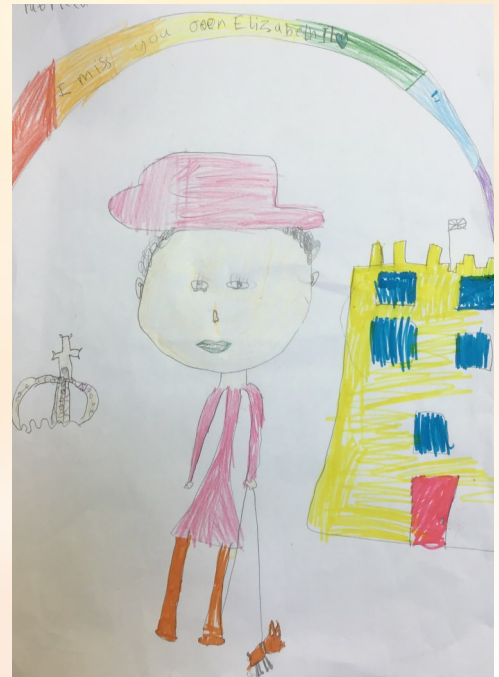

Who was Queen Elizabeth?

Elizabeth was a princess who became the queen of the UK and she was head of state for 15 countries around the world including Australia, Jamaica and Canada. She was queen for 70 years.

- She was queen for 70 years

Loved by her country and millions across the world. Longest serving British monarch in history.
Head of the Commonwealth. Served as important symbols for national identity and pride. Boosted the morale of Britain during WWII.

- She loved animals, especially her porgie (dog) and her horses, which she used to ride.

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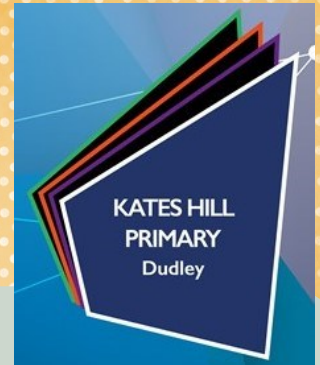
