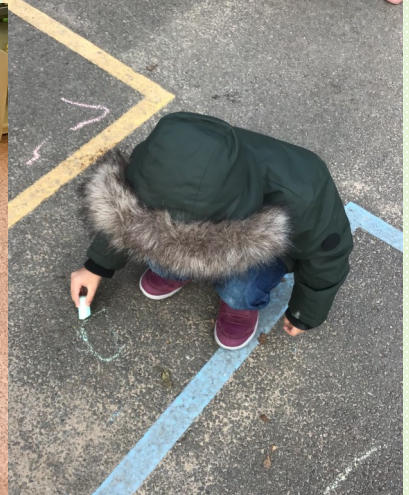

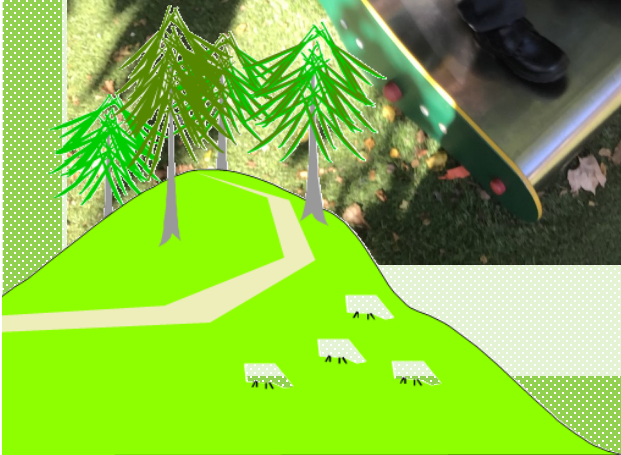

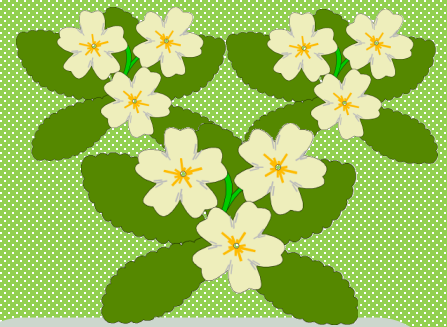
Reception

Can you find England on your map?



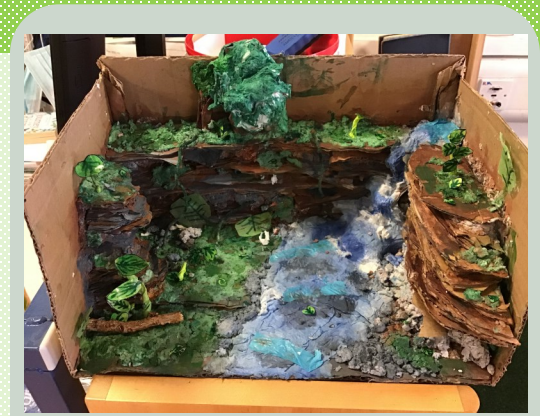
Self Belief

As you can see they are extremely impressive.

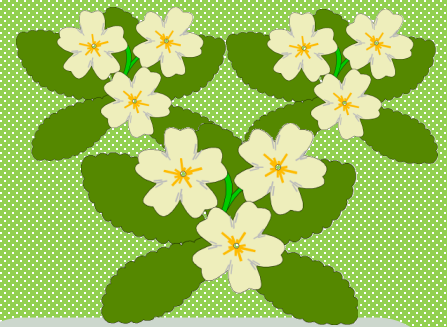


Volcanoes

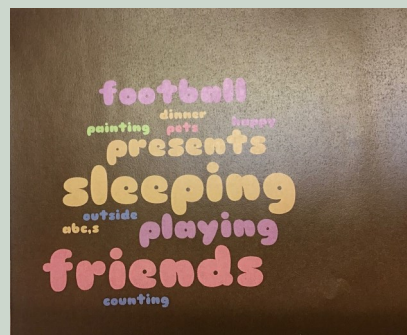
Year 5 children helped to plant around the raised pond and flowerbeds at the front of the school. All had fun and did a great job.
