All children who walk to school, will receive a teacher's stamp on their own record sheet (kept at school) for each day they walk. We hope that this will encourage our families and staff, to try where possible to walk to school over this week.

We hope that this will help and remind our pupils how to safely cross the road and encourage them to continue travelling in a safe, active way.

**THE GREEN CROSS CODE**

A thorough knowledge of the Green Cross Code is vitally important to primary school children **over 7 years**:

1. First find a safe place to cross
2. Stop just before you get to the kerb
3. Look all around for traffic and listen
4. If traffic is coming, let it pass, look all around again and listen
5. When it is safe go straight across the road - do not run
6. Keep looking and listening for traffic while you cross

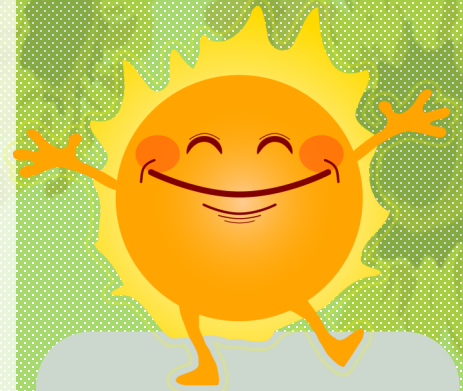

WINNERS



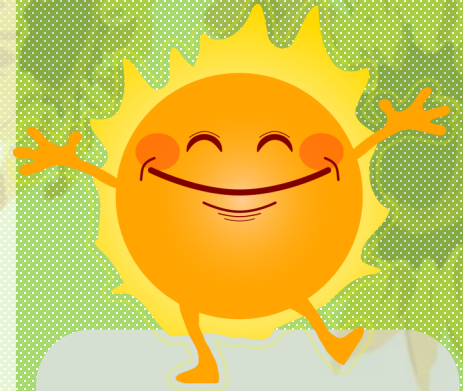
Our netball team represented our school at the Dudley North Schools' competition two weeks ago. The team came away as winners of the competition which is a brilliant achievement.

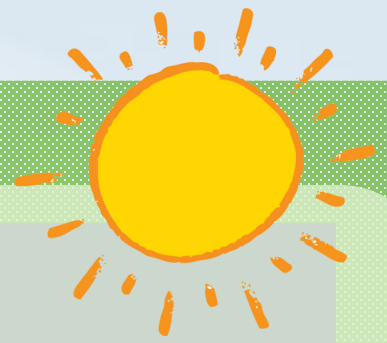

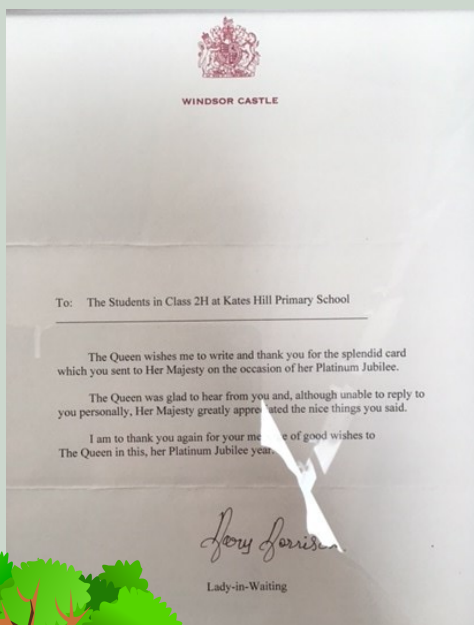


## Congratulations Queen Elizabeth II
