following school instructions on hygiene, such as hand washing and sanitising	<p>Wash/ sanitise hands on entry and exit to/ from school</p> <p>Periodically wash hands and always before eating/ leaving the toilet</p> <p>Pupils to use soap to wash and blue paper to dry.</p>
following instructions on who pupils can socialise with at school	<p>Pupils to stay only in their group and at their designated teaching space</p> <p>Pupils to not be allowed to freely move around the classroom</p>
moving around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing)	<p>Movement around school to be limited. No pupil is to be in the corridor alone.</p> <p>All pupils keep to the left of the corridors when moving.</p> <p>Pupils are only allowed outside and in their designated classroom.</p>
expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes with hands	<p>Multiple tissues to be in every classroom</p> <p>If pupils sneeze or cough pupils to immediately wash hands. If mouth has not been covered . the pupil must wipe down their own table under the direction of the teacher.</p>
tell an adult if you are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus	<p>tell an adult if you are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus</p>
rules about sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles	<p>All pupils will have their own equipment. There is no sharing of resources. School will provide this. No pencil cases from home.</p> <p>All equipment lives in their designated teaching space</p>
amended expectations about breaks or play times, including where children may or may not play	<p>Breaks times are staggered. Two groups out at a time but with set zones. No equipment will be provided. Close supervision by staff at all times. Break will last for 15 minutes.</p> <p>Lunch will be eaten in class. They will then have 15 minutes outside (timetabled).</p> <p>Pupils will also be allowed a 15 minute afternoon break. Again this will be timetabled.</p> <p>Timings and rotas will be dependent on numbers of pupils and staffing availability</p>
use of toilets	<p>Timetabled use of toilets. Pupils will be designated toilet time every hour.</p> <p>Toilets will be cleaned periodically through the day.</p> <p>Pupils wash hands after each toilet visit</p>
clear rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person	<p>Coughing/ spitting towards another person is always unacceptable. Pupils parents to be phoned and sent home. Pupils to return under guidance of SLT.</p>
rewards and sanction system where appropriate	<p>School rewards and sanctions system is still in place.</p>
Identify any reasonable adjustments that need to be made for students with more challenging behaviour.	<p>Any pupils who show challenging behaviour will have an individual risk assessment in place.</p>
